A wide diversity of fish species are abundant in the warm waters and will cater for all types of fishing including bottom fishing for Red Emperor and Coral Trout, trolling for Mackerel, Tuna, Barracuda and Marlin, flyfishing for Sailfish, Milkfish,

Bonefish and Queenfish, popper casting for Giant Trevally and Queenfish and bait/lure casting for Barramundi and Mangrove Jack.

Price includes: Transfers, Accommodation aboard Auriga II, all meals, all drinks including beer, wine and basic spirits, use of first grade fishing gear and tackle, qualified skippers, skippered 7m runabouts, all linen and some toiletry items.

Rowley Shoals Broadbill Trip 06

The Rowley Shoals are renowned for their Sailfish and keep a look out on I Fish over the next few weeks for some amazing footage off 'Oceaneer.' This vessel not only takes you out for these awesome fish but when the moon is right, the crew can be talked into a touch of night fishing for yet another Billfish - the amazing Broadbill.

These fish are targeted off the East coast of Australia and Sydney Game Fishing Club even run a tournament on them, but they are a fish that many an angler is yet to catch. The best time to fish for Broadbill is on the full moon and you need to fish through

the night. The crew of Oceaneer are heading out to challenge the Australian record this month for the best Billfish hooked and by the amount they have so far, I reckon the record will be easily beaten!

We have grabbed a date in 2006 which is in the prime time for both Sailfish & Broadbill and we will spend 3 days on the sails and 2 days on the Broadbill. This will be an exclusive trip as we will only be

taking 8 anglers. The dates of this spectacular trip will be 5th October 2006 - 11th October 2006 and at an all inclusive cost of \$5,995 per person this is the kind of trip that you won't do many times in a lifetime.
