## Elephant Fishing during the Easter Break!

Male and Female Elephant Fish migrate from depths of up to 200 meters offshore to enter the shallow coastal waters to breed. Usually this occurs from late February to late April in Victorian waters.

These are the fish we will be chasing during our March Club Trip aboard 38ft Sidewinder.

The trip is due to take place on Sunday 27th March 2005 from 6:30am till 12:30pm at a cost of only \$70 per person.

This will be the third in our series of CFCFC club trips and all are welcome for a fun day out with us during the Easter break.

These fish are only around

during 2 months of the year and the date we have booked is during the prime season for these feisty fellas! They have been known to put up a pretty good fight so make sure you are prepared!

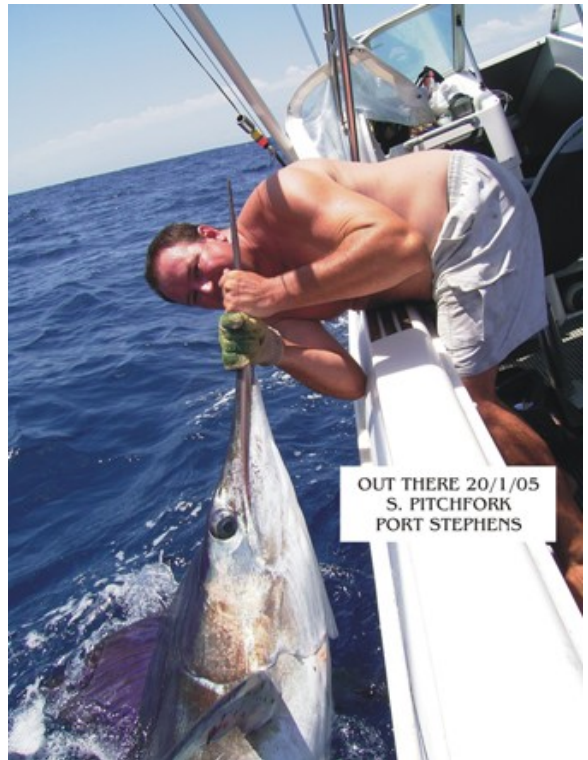
**This is the Corporate Fishing Charters' beloved Steven Pitchfork.**

## What's going on in Mavana?

*An update on our amazing new property in an untouched Fijian Paradise*

Vanua Balavu is an island 40km in length and averages 2km in width, situated 300km North East of the Fijian capitol - Suva.

Your meals will be prepared in Fijian style, consisting of fish, lobster, crabs, chicken, some red meat and spit roast pig, served with locally grown fruit and vegetables such as yams, taro, cassava, bananas, pineapples, mangos, paw paws, avocados and many others.

The lodge is due to be completed by the end of April 2005 and will officially open for business on the 1st of May. Although this is fishing at its very best, you can also take the time to experience the ancient culture of the island, which is still in existence. You can visit some of the villages and mingle with the locals. This is definitely an experience never to be forgotten!
