Bendoroda is a remote river located approximately 1 hour by boat from Popondetta on the North East coast of Papua New Guinea. The rivers in this region are home to healthy populations of Papuan Black Bass. This fish is a member of the Lutjanid family - so is related to the Mangrove Jack, Golden Snapper and Red Emperor. It grows to more than 30kg and inhabits the fresh and brackish waters of the palm fringed tropical rivers of PNG and it is the meanest and toughest fish that any Barra angler is ever likely to encounter!

Your journey begins in Cairns or Brisbane. You will depart early on day one and arrive at Port Moresby to clear customs. You will have an afternoon flight direct to Popondetta where you are met by your host who has been living and working in PNG for over 20 years. Late afternoon transfer to Bendoroda Wilderness Lodge.

On arrival at Bendoroda River, you are greeted by the friendly villagers in full ceremonial dress hitting drums and singing your welcome. After the welcoming you receive a tour of the Lodge which has been made from natural cane and black palm materials. You will fish from fully guided customized 5m sportsfishers after a light cooked breakfast. **Then the adventure begins...!**
